Writing from the Lutheran Confessions

There is nothing for us to do on earth but to pray without ceasing against this archenemy (Satan). For if God did not support us, we would not be safe from him for a single hour. Thus you see how God wants us to pray to him for everything that attacks even our bodily welfare so that we seek and expect help from no one but him. But he has placed at the end this petition (“deliver us from evil”), for if we are to be protected and delivered from all evil, his name must first be hallowed in us, his kingdom come among us, and his will be done. In the end he will preserve us from sin and disgrace and from everything else that harms or injures us. [Large Catechism, III:116-117]
