Only that which brings peace to consciences justifies before God. For we are not righteous and made alive as long as the conscience flees the judgment of God and is angry with God. Furthermore, faith alone brings peace to consciences, according to the passage [Romans 5:1], "Since we are justified by faith we have peace." Likewise [Habakkuk 2:4; Romans 1:17], "The one who is righteous through faith will live," that is, by faith a person conquers the terrors of death, by faith a person is uplifted and receives joy and life. And faith brings this peace not because it is a worthwhile work in and of itself, but only because it receives the promise that is offered and does not look upon its own worthiness. Therefore faith alone justifies, and good works please God on account of faith. [Apology, IV:179]
