Writing from the Lutheran Confessions

If people wish to be saved, they should not concern or torture themselves with thoughts about the secret counsel of God—whether they are chosen and preordained for eternal life—with which the accursed Satan is wont to attack and trouble upright hearts. Rather, they should listen to Christ, who is the “Book of Life” and the book of God’s eternal election for all God’s children to eternal life [Philippians 4:3; Revelation 3:5; 20:15]. For he testifies to all people without distinction that God wills all people who are burdened and weighed down with sins to come to him, so that they may be given rest and be saved [Matthew 11:28].
